## **KEEPING WHAT I GOT FROM GOD**

**Luk 22:31** And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:

Luk 22:32 But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

**Joh 21:15** So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.

Joh 21:16 He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Joh 21:17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Joh 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

<u>1Jn</u> <u>5:2</u> By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

1Jn 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

Act 18:17 Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and <u>beat him before</u> <u>the judgment seat.</u> And Gallio cared for none of those things.

Act 18:18 And Paul *after this* tarried *there* yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn *his* head in Cenchrea: for he had a yow.

Act 18:19 And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered into the synagogue, and reasoned with the Jews.

Act 18:20 When they desired him to tarry longer time with them, he consented not:

Act 18:21 But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

Act 18:22 And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up, and saluted the church, he went down to Antioch.

**Act 18:23** And after he had spent some time *there*, he departed, and went over *all* the country of Galatia and Phrygia in order, *strengthening all the disciples*.

**Psa 51:12** Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me *with thy* free spirit.

Psa 51:13 Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee.

(Act 1:8 KJV) But <u>ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost</u> is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Jud 1:20 But ye, beloved, <u>building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,</u>

Jud 1:21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

Jud 1:22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:

(Job 22:23 KJV) *If thou return to the Almighty, thou shalt be built up*, thou shalt put away iniquity far from thy tabernacles.

(Act 9:31 KJV) Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

(Act 14:22 KJV) Confirming the souls of the disciples, *and* exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

(Act 20:32 KJV) And now, brethren, *I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up,* and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

(Rom 15:2 KJV) Let every one of us please his neighbour for his good to edification.

(Rom 15:14 KJV) And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, *able also to admonish one another*.

(1Pe 2:5 KJV) Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, <u>to offer up</u> spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

**2Pe 1:5** And *beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith* virtue; and to virtue knowledge;

- 2Pe 1:6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;
- 2Pe 1:7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.
- **2Pe** 1:8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make *you that ye shall* neither *be* barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2Pe 1:9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.
- 2Pe 1:10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if
