

HAVE YOU CROSSED OVER IN YOUR SPIRIT

WILLING SPIRIT

Psa 119:4-5; Psa 119:24-25; Psa 119:32; Psa 119:35-37; Psa 119:40; Psa 119:115; Psa 119:117; Psa 119:173-174, Son 3:2, +*Isa 26:8; +*Isa 26:9, Luk 9:55; Luk 22:33, Rom 7:18-25; Rom 8:3, 1Co 9:27, Gal 5:16-17; Gal 5:24, Php 3:12-14.

Exo 35:21 And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, *and* they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.

Mat 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

1Pe 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

(1Jn 3:13 KJV) Marvel not, my brethren, if the world hate you.

(1Jn 3:14 KJV) **We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.**

(1Jn 3:15 KJV) Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.

(1Jn 3:16 KJV) Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and **we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.**

(1Jn 3:17 KJV) But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?

(1Jn 3:18 KJV) My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth.

(Joh 5:24 KJV) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

(Joh 8:54 KJV) Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

(Joh 8:55 KJV) Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.

(Act 17:27 KJV) That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us:

(1Jn 3:2 KJV) Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

(1Jn 3:19 KJV) And hereby **we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him.**

(1Jn 5:2 KJV) By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

(1Jn 5:13 KJV) These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

(1Jn 5:19 KJV) **And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.**

(1Jn 5:20 KJV) And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

(1Jn 2:9 KJV) He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.

(1Jn 2:10 KJV) He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.

(1Jn 2:11 KJV) But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes.

THE JAILER AND THE WORLD

(Act 16:22 KJV) And the multitude rose up together against them: and the magistrates rent off their clothes, and commanded to beat *them*.

(Act 16:23 KJV) And when they had laid many stripes upon them, they cast *them* into prison, charging the jailor to keep them safely:

(Act 16:24 KJV) Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.

(Act 16:33 KJV) And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed *their* stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway.

(Act 16:34 KJV) And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, believing in God with all his house.

(Eph 2:1 KJV) And you *hath he quickened*, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

(Eph 2:5 KJV) Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

(Col 1:13 KJV) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son:

(1Jn 3:14 KJV) We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not *his* brother abideth in death.
